Appalachia Service Project (ASP) is a Christian ministry, open to all people, that inspires hope and service through volunteer home repair and replacement for low-income families in Central Appalachia. This fall we will journey back to Jonesville, VA - the ASP headquarters. On a service trip like this, along with home repairs, you can expect to also form relationships with homeowners and community members, learning about the Appalachian region and come away with a rejuvenated spirit to serve.

We will leave Wednesday, October 9 in the afternoon and arrive back in Greensboro later in the afternoon on Saturday, October 12. Workdays are from 8:30 am - 4:30 pm working in groups of 5 - 7 people. The evenings are reserved for time for fellowship, reflection, sharing, local musicians and other free time. Normally last night our group goes out for Mexican food.

Because ASP has a certain number of volunteers set aside for each work week, it tends to fill up fast for the October dates. As a result, the deadline to sign up with a non-refundable deposit of \$50 is Thursday, June 6. This gives us time to add more slots if we need.
