Baby Steffan was rescued by a Good Samaritan who later took him to hospital. His medical records indicate he was born on 8/10/09, weighing 3.4kg.

He remained in hospital until 28/10/09 when he was admitted at **New Life Home Trust**.

He has enjoyed good health and his weight is now 4.8kgs and he loves being held .He is still being nursed at the Intensive Care Unit.



GARRY

Baby Garry was abandoned at a waste disposal site wrapped in a paper bag. The cord was still intact and tested HIV negative. He had scars on the scalp and the left hand was stiff. He was put on antibiotics due to neonatal sepsis.

He is doing well and his hand has now improved. He weighs 4000gms.
